Misty Creek

This medium bodied wine is made up of equal parts barrel fermented Chardonal and steel fermented Chardonal giving it a lightly oaked aroma with hints of green apple and peanuts. The taste is crisp and refreshing and lingers on the palate.

Pêche Blanc **\$14.99**

Dave **\$14.99**

Kringle's Cranberry **\$15.50**

Chocolate Cherry Sherry **\$15.49**
This is chocolate candy in a bottle. Moderately sweet with a plum and spice flavor. Begins with the dark chocolate taste and follows with cherry fruit flavor. Outstanding!

DESSERT WINE

Blue Ice **\$15.99**
A white, Illinois dessert wine made from the Traminette grape. Enjoy the richness of honey, roses, and pineapple in this wine.

Nort Noir **\$16.49**
Won the Governor's Cup in 2009. Named "Noir" after its dark color, and "Nort" for the Norton grape so popular in the Midwest, this Port-style wine is the best dessert wine in the State of Illinois. The nice nutty flavor enhanced by oak results in a smooth, almost caramelized finish.

Chamery **\$16.49**
A fine mahogany-colored sweet sherry wine from the Chambourcin grape. It has a nose of alcohol, sugar, and nuts with a nice long finish. Before or after dinner, this makes for a very relaxing drink.

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
